



Eligibility

All tradespeople must verify “Full Time” in their trade before being allowed to write a Journeyman examination. “Full Time” is outlined in the regulations governing each trade.

Examinations will only be administered to those who have received a final notice letter from the Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission to attend the examination at a given place and date. Such notice will be mailed to those who have met the following conditions:

- **First time applicants submit a Form 7 and a fee of \$480. Second and subsequent applications should be made on a Form 2 with a fee of \$100 for a written exam and \$160 for a practical exam.**
- The request must be accompanied by Verification of Trade Experience (Form 6A), confirming “Full Time” (If “Full Time” was previously established, the Form 6A’s are not required.)
- **The request must be delivered or mailed to:** Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission, 2140 Hamilton Street, Regina, Saskatchewan, S4P 2E3, **no later than the 1st day of the month prior to the month of the desired examination date** (e.g. request for February 2008 examination to be delivered or postmarked on or prior to January 1, 2008).

Those commencing initial employment in the **Electrician, Plumber, or Sheet Metal Worker** trades on or after **December 1, 1976**, and in the **Refrigeration Mechanic** trade on or after **December 1, 1988**, must become indentured as apprentices.

To be eligible for a journeyman examination tradespeople in:
Carpenter, Concrete Finisher, Insulator or Power Lineperson trades must:
(a) verify “Full Time” trade experience, and
(b) successfully complete prescribed upgrading training.

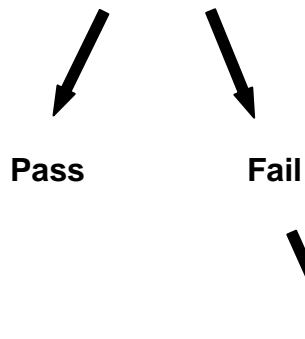
Journeyman examinations in these trades consist of written and practical examinations. Candidates require a pass mark of 70% in the written examination before being eligible to apply for the practical examination.

Journey person Trade Examinations

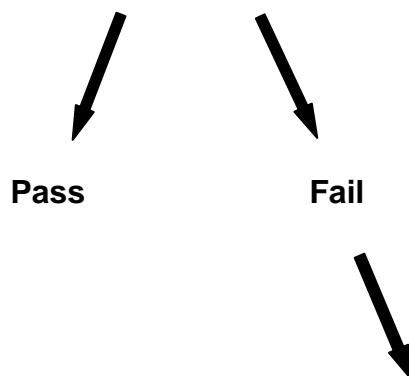
What do I have to do if I fail?

Attempt No. 1



A person must wait at least three months before writing again.

Attempt No. 2, 3 or 4



A person must wait at least three months and complete any upgrading approved by the Director.

Fail on 4th attempt.

No further attempts.

Remember, you no longer have an unlimited number of attempts to write the journey person trade examination.

If an apprentice fails on the last possible attempt to write the examination, their apprenticeship contract will be cancelled.
